**The Williamsburg-Bermuda Connection**  
**March 20-25, 2012**

**Tuesday, March 20**

Our splendid tour begins with a gala welcome reception and dinner at *Cambridge Beaches*. This exquisite oasis of calm and tranquility at the ocean's edge offers superb accommodations and fine dining with lovely vistas and sunsets.

**Wednesday, March 21**

This morning, Ed Chappell will escort us to historic *St. George's*, Bermuda's original capital and a *UNESCO World Heritage Site*. Ed will lead a walking tour around the picturesque old town as we focus on its history as told through its architecturally significant buildings. St. George's celebrates its 400th anniversary in 2012.

**Thursday, March 22**

This morning, Ed Chappell will escort us to some of Bermuda's most beautiful homes, a rare privilege indeed. We conclude the morning with a private visit to *Verdmont*, the crown jewel of the historic homes held by the Bermuda National Trust. Lunch will follow in *Hamilton* the modern capital city and an afternoon walking tour of its impressive sites.

**Friday, March 23**

Today we stroll through the lovely *Botanical Gardens* surrounding *Camden* (the official residence of the premier of Bermuda), which we shall visit. We continue on to the *Masterworks Gallery*, then to *Old Devonshire Church*, one of the island's oldest and most beautiful, and then on to *Orange Grove* for a private lunch at one of Bermuda's loveliest estates.

**Saturday, March 24**

On our final day, we explore the beautiful western end of the island and the fascinating *Royal Naval Dockyards*. We will have a private tour of the *Commissioner's House* and time to explore the *Bermuda Maritime Museum* and its magnificent fortifications. This evening, enjoy a gala reception at one of Bermuda's premier residences, followed by a delicious farewell dinner at Cambridge Beaches.

**\*SINGLE ROOMS:** A limited number of single rooms are available at extra cost on a first-come, first-served basis, but availability cannot be guaranteed. We will be happy to assist persons requesting a roommate, however neither a single room, nor a share, can be guaranteed. Individual participants desiring to share a room will be notified if we are unsuccessful in finding a suitable roommate. In such cases, the single supplement or single arrangements rate will be charged.

**TOUR COSTS INCLUDE:** First-class hotel accommodations based on two persons sharing twin- or double-bedded room with private bath (single room supplement will be charged when required or requested); meals as indicated in itinerary; wine included with most meals; comprehensive educational program including services of study leaders, local experts and professional guides; all special visits and excursions; all transportation and sightseeing as indicated in itinerary; entrance fees; group transfers to/from Bermuda International Airport to/from Cambridge Beaches Resort & Spa; service charges and basic gratuities.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Transportation to and from tour start and finish locations (USA-Bermuda); visa and passport fees, photos and processing whenever applicable; meals not specified in itinerary; personal items such as wines, liquors, a-la-carte orders not specified in itinerary; room service, telephone, fax or Internet connection fees, and valet/laundry charges; costs incurred by our tour operators to make individual arrangements before or after a program; and other items not specifically mentioned as included.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** Refunds of deposits, less a \$500 per person cancellation fee, will be made only if your place(s) can be resold. Cancellation 60 days prior to departure: no refund. No refunds for unused portions of a tour including but not limited to, missed meals, hotel nights, and sightseeing. Cancellation of program by Colonial Williamsburg Foundation or our tour operators: full refund. Should events beyond the control of Colonial Williamsburg Foundation or any of our tour operators necessitate the cancellation of a program while on tour, a full refund of land costs will be calculated based on the cost of services used up to the time of the group's return.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** Colonial Williamsburg Foundation strongly recommends that all tour participants purchase Trip Cancellation, Emergency Medical Evacuation, Baggage, Accident and Medical Insurance for their tour. Upon receipt of your initial tour deposit, a Trip Insurance Plan will be mailed to you.
